

# AUTHOR VISIT WITH DANIELLE DAVIS (virtual or in-person)

## OPTION 1: <u>TO MAKE</u> + MAKING PLAN

Picture book reading; imaginative video; an an interactive discussion of the story, creative process, and patience. Plus, an inspiring activity for kids to draw/write their own sequential plan to make something wonderful. Optional craft if materials provided. Approx. 30 minutes to 1 hour.

#### A chance for children to explore creative process.

# **OPTION 2: "TO MAKE A STORY" WRITING WORKSHOP**

Children will write a collaborative story via the steps, "gather, make, wait" that correspond to phases of the writing process. They'll leave with tools to write one on their own. Together, we'll *gather* story elements from <u>To Make</u>, *make* a story according to their choices, and *wait* for our revision to be done in order to celebrate and share it. Approx. 30 minutes to 1 hour.

#### A chance for children to collaboratively write a story using source material.

*Self-awareness*: identifying emotions, recognizing strengths, positive self-concept, self-efficacy. *Self-management*: stress management, goal-setting, self-motivation, organization.

Social awareness: empathy, appreciating diversity, respect for others.

*Relationship skills*: communication, cooperation, seeking and offering help, negotiating conflict. *Responsible decision-making*: identifying, analyzing, and solving problems.
